#### **HOA Lot Fees**

<u>Lot Fee Cost</u> – Your deed requires that you pay a mere **\$10/Lot/Year** to help cover the cost of benefits we all enjoy (i.e., street lights, waterfront, and playground).

<u>Delinquent Lot Fees</u> – The Delinquent Late Fee charge is equal to your Lot Fee and will be charged after July 31st. Prevent Late Fees and pay ahead.

**Pool Use** – Pool is open Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day weekend. Hollywood Shores residents must be a member to use the pool. Bring your membership card to show the lifeguard and sign-in.

**Pool Rental** – Pool Parties cost \$80 (+ \$50 Deposit) must have paid Lifeguard. You can rent the Pool after/before hours only. Visit our website for details.

# <u>Gate Access</u> - YOUR GATE ACCESS CARD REOUIRES A CURRENT MEMBERSHIP.

Keycards from last year remain valid if you renew your membership on or before Spring Meeting.

- 1. Anyone living in Hollywood Shores may walk to the Beach Area and Pier. Car Access is with Card only.
- 2. Please renew your membership before the Spring Meeting or your Card will be deactivated.
- 3. Display your Car Pass in your windshield when parked at the beach area.
- 4. New members will receive one card per membership.
- 5. If you lose your card, it will be de-activated and a new one issued for \$5. Do not let others use your card. This will result in the loss of your Gate Access privilege.
- 6. Please wait for the Gate to open completely before driving through.

#### **General Information**

**Beach Parking** – Only current members of Hollywood Shores are authorized to use the gate. All other vehicles are trespassing. Vehicles/trailers should back into the creek side of the parking lot (See drawing on page 4). **Do not block the boat ramp or piers. Beach Area is CLOSED 10 PM – 5 AM.** 

WFC Chores for Clean Up Weekends - The board has a list of tasks that are needed before pool and boat ramp/docks opening. Some are new, others are reoccurring (see below). Come to the pool house where a board member can identify a task to match your talents.

- 1) Pool, Pool House, and Pump House: Pressure wash pool, prime and paint pool, paint pool ladders, caulk cracks. Install diving board and teeter-totter. Clean refrigerator and pool house, check/replace shower curtains, trim hedges, and clean pump house.
- 2) Mowing and Weed Eating Mow and weed-eat property, trim trees and hedges.
- 3) **Beach Area** Clean up beach and picnic areas (pick up trash), mow and weed-eating property, trim trees, install weed stop fabric and spread mulch.

## **Safety & Security Notices**

**Security Cameras:** Thanks to our new one man **I-T Committee**, we now have high quality security cameras with views of the Pool, Parking areas, Waterfront Gate, and now the waterfront area! With the recording capability, we are able to scroll through time and capture any event as needed. We have even captured entertaining videos of local wildlife. Anyone trespassing or tampering with the gate will face legal action. Your picture will be sent to the police department for identification and prosecution. **House Numbers:** Need to be clearly posted on your mail box and house for fire and rescue to find your home.

Golf Carts, Go Carts, Dirt Bikes and ATVs: we've all seen golf carts rolling around and, most of the time, they are operated safely. However, this hasn't always been the case. Kids driving a vehicle not authorized for use on public roads puts the owners of the vehicle at risk legally and financially. PLEASE, if you own a cart or ATV, help us avoid terrible accidents and tell your kids to play it safe! Teach them the rules of the road; stop signs mean STOP, look before you pull out onto a road, stay in your lane, and do not dart across lanes.

**Driving thru Stop Signs and Speeding**: We have had several reports of speeding vehicles and resulting "close calls". This time of year, there are lots of kids and dogs and walkers in the streets in your neighborhood. PLEASE slow down and **STOP** at STOP Signs as you enter and drive through the Shores!

- ➤ Children should be closely monitored at the waterfront as the currents are very fast and water is deep adjacent to the sea wall.
- ➤ Please be considerate of your neighbors, the St Mary's County Residential Maximum Noise Level from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am is 55 dB.
- ➤ Dogs are required to be on a leash. It is OK if you are exercising your dog at the waterfront, but please make sure other people are not there. Please respect walking paths and yards by ALWAYS removing your dog's poop!

We can continue to maintain a clean, healthy environment in Hollywood Shores by working together!
